At the direction of the Mayor and City Council, city staff has completed a review of the potential factors for the safety and the free flow of motorists traveling the city streets and the impact of introducing Golf Carts if the council decided to allow them.

After our review, it is our recommendation that pursuant to O.C.G.A § 40-6-330.1 and §40-6-331, the city may allow the use of Golf Carts as a means of personal transportation on all streets designated and identified on the map attached to this memorandum.

It is our recommendation that we draft an ordinance that complies with O.C.G.A §40-6-331, with the exception of subsection (b) regarding a requirement to inspect, permits and collect a \$15.00 fee. Until such time that Golf Carts become a safety concern due to their regular use, staff feels that it would be more a tax on city resources, rather than a benefit to public welfare.
