- 7:00PM Councilman Adams welcomed everyone and introduced the meeting facilitator, Mr. Eric Robinson from the Carl Vinson Institute of Government.
- 7:10pm Mr. Robinson went over the agenda and rules of the night.
- 7:15PM Traffic Engineer, Chief Glavosek gave a city overview and went over initiatives. He said that the Police Department is being proactive in making sure everyone is safe. He then went over statistics for accidents in Hapeville; commenting that there isn't a whole lot of issues with the neighborhoods. However, when called out to a problem, staff gather numbers and compile reports based on data and any trends would be presented to Council. The process is outlined in the ordinance.
- 7:40PM Chief Glavosek answered questions from residents regarding traffic concerns. Questions were asked by: Joan Shorter, Laura Murphy, Lucy Dolan, Larry Martin, John Stalvey, and Ms. Walker (some names were not provided).
- 7:50PM Residents were divided into groups according to which side of the city they reside on. Each group was tasked to come up with traffic solutions for their area. Also, each person was given a short survey to rank their traffic issues in their neighborhoods.
- 8:00PM Residents were given time within their groups to discuss traffic issues and to come up with solutions
- 8:20PM Each group presented their solutions to everyone.
- 9:00PM Councilman Adams gave closing remarks thanking everyone for coming out. He said it is very important that the citizen voices are heard. The next step is to meet as a team to identify, prioritize, and determine which traffic calming methods are needed based off of information Mr. Robinson compiles together.
