**Hapeville History**

On January 8, 1821, the Creek Nation Indians ceded a large tract of land to the colonist which included the present Hapeville area. In 1853 that land was incorporated into Fulton County. Hapeville grew out of individual farm settlements owned by the Thrailkill, Cash, Mangum, Sims and Hape families. The village of Hapeville was chartered on September 16, 1891 by Dr. Samuel Hape, Hapeville's first Mayor. Hape was a native of Middlebury, Maryland who came to Atlanta prior to the Civil War.

The most significant impact on Hapeville's future occurred when Asa G. Candler, Jr. allowed the center of his oval race track to be used as a landing field for aircrafts. The city of Atlanta purchased this area in 1929 and founded its municipal airport, which eventually became the world's busiest airport known as Hartsfield-Jackson International Airport.

### **REGISTRATION RULES & REGULATIONS**

#### *Athletics:*

- No fee may be paid to the coach. All fees must be paid to the Hapeville Recreation Department.
- Deadline dates are two weeks prior to the actual beginning date (unless otherwise noted).

#### *Programs:*

- Advanced registration is necessary for most classes. Fees must be paid to instructor in most cases prior to class start date.

### **Cancellations & Refunds**

The Recreation Department reserves the right to cancel any class due to insufficient registration. If cancellation is necessary, anyone registered will be informed and a full refund shall be automatically issued from your instructor or mailed to your residence from the City if applicable.

### **Photography policy**

The staff, on occasion, may photograph our citizens, registrants and participants in Recreation programs, special events or facilities. Such photographs are for department use only and may be used in publications, brochures, pamphlets, flyers or video production for the city.

The Hapeville Recreation Department coordinates reservations for the parks and facilities that are available for rental. Listed below are the locations as well as the fees. Terms, agreements, insurance and fees will be determined upon reservation. All rentals are **First-Come First-Served Reservations (2 weeks to 6 months in advance)**.

**DEPOSIT: ALL GROUPS ARE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE A DEPOSIT OF \$100.** Deposits are refunded in part or whole upon inspection of the facility at the conclusion of the reservation. Deposit refunds are issued by the City of Hapeville and should be received after inspection of rented area. If the deposit does not cover the cost of damages, a bill will be issued for the balance. Failure to pay for additional costs within a 30 day period will result in denied future reservation requests and a referral of accounts for legal collection.


