The Department had 35 fire inspections, 15 new construction site visits, 3 plan reviews, 15 pre-fire plans, 85 blood pressures checked and 84 hours of Firefighters on patrol. Four smoke detectors were given out to residents within the community and 30 children participated in Fire Safety Education. During the month of May, the Department conducted training in the following areas: Fire Prevention and Public Education, Water Supply, Equipment Familiarization review, New Hire Driver Training. All EMTs and Paramedics continued reviewing the third part of the new Atlanta Regional Protocols for EMS. All shifts continued conducting the yearly hose testing. All three shifts participated in the annual Georgia Firefighters Burn Foundation Boot Drive, collecting approximately \$4000.00. The Medical Truck was posted at Saint John's Catholic School field day to provide medical assistance if it was required. Two members of the Department supported this year's Memorial Day Ceremony by being part of the color guard. The Departments Fire Marshal attended the Underground Pipelines Emergency and Response training focus on petroleum and gas lines.

From May 1, 2014 to May 31, 2014, the Police Department answered (542) calls for service. There was (1) Assault, (8) Burglaries, (1) Carjacking, (1) Robbery, (40) Larcenies; including (16) Entering Autos, (6) Stolen Vehicles and (18) Thefts. The Department made 67 arrests. Average Response Time was 1 minute 32 seconds. There was a total of (414) tickets to include (305) Traffic tickets, (69) General and (40) Parking. The Department conducted 4 Road Safety Checks and recovered 5 stolen vehicles.

The Detective Division assigned (47) cases for investigation, and closed (57) cases. Three cases were closed with arrest warrants and (1) by CID arrest. The Detective Division obtained (14) warrants and responded to (18) crime scenes and executed (1) search warrant. The Detective Division is investigating a carjacking that occurred at the intersection of Sherman Rd and King Arnold St. The Detective Division is investigating multiple commercial burglaries that occurred on Memorial Day in the business complex of Virginia Crossings located at 1001 Virginia Avenue.

Department personnel continue to receive daily roll-call and in-service training on topics such as (but not limited to) the Department's standard operating procedures (SOP), Special Orders, Family Violence, Juvenile Procedures, Officer Safety, Department's Goals & Objectives.

Code Enforcement handled (155) new calls for service, of which: (25) were animal incidents, (31) for outside storage violations, (10) for parking on the grass, (8) Permit Violations and (81) were other code compliance issues. The unit wrote (42) citations, closed (252) cases, and has (114) active cases.
