During the month of November, the Department conducted the following 24 pre-fire plans, 11 site consultations, 6 business licenses inspections, 72 blood pressure checks, 3 fire protection inspections, and 4 certificates of occupancy. A total of 11 yearly inspections were also completed. Our personnel completed in house and off-site training to include the following: New Hotel Familiarization, Fire & EMS Report Writing, Medical Emergencies Part I & II, Fire Officer I & II, Patient Care Reporting, EMS Organization, Truck 2 Drivers Training, and National Fire Incident Reporting System. Our Fire Chief and Deputy Chief attended the monthly South Fulton Chiefs meeting hosted by the Fairburn Fire Department. Also, the Fire Chief, Deputy Chief, Training Division Chief and Fire Marshal attended the Winecoff Hotel Fire presentation at the Georgia Public Safety Training Center in Forsyth, GA. Our Deputy Fire Chief and Training Division Chief continue to collaborate on all the training planning for the upcoming year. Between November 1, 2021, and November 3, 2021, there were (489) calls for service. There were (2) Assaults, (2) Burglaries, (1) Robbery, (57) Larcenies, including 46 Entering Autos, 3 Stolen Vehicles and 8 Thefts. The Department recovered (7) Stolen Vehicles. The Department made 36 arrests. Average Response time was 02 min 44 secs.

The Department issued 444 citations to include parking, traffic, and general copies.

**We are unable to report the number of calls processed through the E-911 center as AT&T's software is currently down.

The Detective Division reviewed (612) cases, assigned (20) cases for investigation, and closed (28) cases. (3) Cases were closed with arrest warrants and (1) by CID arrest. The Detective Division obtained (16) warrants, responded to (3) crime scenes for investigation and executed (1) search warrant(s).

Code Enforcement: Code Enforcement handled (121) new calls for service. Of these calls, the unit documented (4) animal incidents, (26) parking in grass, (2) tall grass & weeds, (8) permit issues, (47) outside storage, (6) littering or pollution problems, (1) Yard Debris and (9) property maintenance- exterior. The unit closed (88) cases and issued (3) citations.
