During the month of December, the Department conducted the following: 1 site consultation, 14 business licenses inspections, 72 blood pressure checks, and 4 general consultations. Our personnel completed in house and off-site training to include the following: New Hotel Familiarization, New Driver Training, Defensive Driving Course, National Fire Incident Reporting System, Company Training, EMS Refresher Class and New Hotel Pack Load. The Fire Chief and Deputy Chief, attended the monthly South Fulton Chiefs meeting hosted by the Fairburn Fire Department. Also, our Fire Chief, Deputy Chief, Training Division Chief, and Fire Marshal, attended the Winecoff Hotel Fire presentation at the Georgia Public Safety Training Center in Forsyth, GA. The Deputy Fire Chief continues to update the Department Covid protocols in accordance with the CDC recommended guidelines. The Training Division Chief has updated the Sergeant's Orientation packet in preparation for the upcoming promotional assessment process to be held in March 2022. A member of the Department obtained the National Professional Qualification Fire Instructor I certification. The Assistant Fire Marshal completed the Georgia Fire Academy Fire Service Plan Examiner course. We provided mutual aid to the College Park Fire Department during a hotel fire call.

Between December 1, 2021, and December 31, 2021, there were (424) calls for service. There were (5) Assaults, (1) Burglary, (2) Robberies, (28) Larcenies, including 15 Entering Autos, 2 Stolen Vehicles and 11 Thefts. The Department recovered (9) Stolen Vehicles and (2) Stolen Property Items. The Department made 40 arrests. Average Response time was 02 min 45 secs.

The Department issued 400 citations to include parking, traffic, and general copies.

The E-911 center processed 3,002 calls for service.

The Detective Division reviewed (508) cases, assigned (28) cases for investigation, and closed (28) cases. (4) Cases were closed with arrest warrants and (1) by CID arrest. The Detective Division obtained (6) warrants, responded to (4) crime scenes for investigation and executed (1) search warrant(s).

Code Enforcement: Code Enforcement handled (71) new calls for service. Of these calls, the unit documented (4) animal incidents, (18) parking in grass, (0) tall grass & weeds, (6) permit

issues, (34) outside storage, (0) littering or pollution problems, (2) Yard Debris and (3) property maintenance- exterior. The unit closed (61) cases and issued (0) citations.
