During the month of October, the Department conducted the following annual 20 inspections, 15 new construction site visits, 4 plans reviews, 1 fire alarm inspection, and reviewing APCU sprinkler plans. The Fire Department conducted 8 additional hours of online fire reporting systems updates, and the transitioning of Image Trend Elite software from v3.4 to v3.5. Our department has 5 candidates (Bravy Jr., Hughes-Rembert, Johnson, Rose, & Singletary) who just completed their Firefighter 2 class and will be testing their skills in November. The Fire Department completed 88 hours of training.

Between October 1, 2023, and October 31, 2023, there were (574) calls for service. There were (2) Assaults, (1) Burglary, (1) Robbery, (34) Larcenies, including 14 Entering Autos, 6 Stolen Vehicles, and 14 Thefts. The Department recovered (13) Stolen Vehicles and (2) Stolen Property Items. The Department made 63 arrests. The average response time was 02 mins 43 secs.

The Department issued 672 citations, including parking, traffic, and general copies.

The E-911 Center processed 2,913 calls for service.

The Detective Division reviewed (816) cases, assigned (32) cases for investigation, and closed (26) cases. (2) Cases were closed with arrest warrants and (3) by CID arrest. The Detective Division obtained (11) warrants, responded to (4) crime scenes for investigation and executed (1) search warrant(s).

Code Enforcement October 2023: Code Enforcement handled (272) new calls for service. Of these calls, the unit documented (11) animal incidents, (19) parking in grass, (10) parking issues, (6) inoperable vehicles, (105) tall grass & weeds, (14) permit issues, (14) outside storage, (82) littering or pollution problems, (1) tree removal without permit, (1) premise number violation, (1) noise violation, and (8) property maintenance- exterior. The unit closed (207) cases and issued (7) citations.

2023 Tax Billing:

On October 16, 2023, The City of Hapeville mailed 2,706 tax bills to citizens and business owners. Property taxes are due Wednesday, November 29, 2023. A penalty will automatically be charged for all unpaid tax obligations on **Thursday, November 30, 2023**. Monthly

interest on delinquent accounts will begin accumulating on **Thursday**, **December 14**, **2023**. Failure to receive a tax bill does not exempt penalties or interest.

Stormwater Fees:

Staff is focusing on delinquent stormwater fees. Stormwater fees are not included in property tax billings, nor are the fees a part of the monthly utility bill. Stormwater fees are annual fees collected to support the Stormwater Management Program. All stormwater fees are the responsibility of the homeowner.
