General Fund expenditures amounted to \$9,420,955 for the eleven months ended May 31, 2010. Budgeted expenditures on average for the same period amounted to \$10,107,086 resulting in a positive budget variance of \$686,181.

From May 16, 2010 to June 15, 2010, the Police Department answered 636 calls for service. There were 4 reports of Assault, 10 Residential Burglaries, 1 Commercial Burglary, 1 Robbery, 0 Child Molestations and 24 other Larcenies.

The Department closed 37 cases with arrests and issued 4 additional arrest warrants. There were 233 citations written and an average of 3 minute response time was maintained.

The Detective Division received 120 new cases, cleared 2 cases by arrest and obtained 4 arrest warrants.

Uniform Personnel have been receiving daily roll-call training that covers city ordinances, state criminal and traffic laws, and the Department's Standard Operating Procedures.

Code Enforcement handled 164 new calls for service, of which 64 were animal incidents and 100 were code compliance issues. The Unit closed 127 cases with compliance and issued 100 citations for code violations.

Alfred Martin and Brett Hunter graduated Basic Police Mandate training and are currently assigned to the uniform patrol and are undergoing field training.
