## Title VI

## **Notice to Public**

The City of Hapeville hereby gives public notice of it's policy to uphold and assure full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, The Civil Rights Restoration Act of 1987, and all related statutes. Title VI and related statutes prohibiting discrimination in federally-assisted programs require that no person in the United States of America shall, on the grounds of race, color, national origin, sex, age, or disability be excluded from the participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving Federal assistance.

Any person who believes they have been aggrieved by an unlawful discriminatory practice regarding the City of Hapeville's program has a right to file a formal complaint with the City. Any such complaint must be in writing and submitted to the City's Title VI Coordinator within 180 days following the date of the alleged occurrence.
